- Tax you are actually helping a client throughout the year giving better consulting than audit
 - Audit you are looking at the client after the financial statements are already done leading to less consulting
- Either audit or tax try to add value to the client
- Any field in accounting, never going to have a cookie cutter day, the field is changing everyday making everyday different

- Don't just do the things you are told, try to actually understand what you are doing
- Don't know what you want to do before you do it, so try both tax and audit to get a better understanding on what you want to do

A Day in the Life at GPW

During the slow period

- Come in between 7:30 to 8:30, usually check on emails first
- Will usually start on or continue a project by mid morning like researching for a client
- Lunch will usually go out to lunch with a client to get to know them and network with them
- Usually in the afternoon will plan a conference call with clients or other meetings of some sort
- End of the day will wrap up with any projects not finished in the mid morning

• Usually leave around 5 or 6 in the evening

During busy season

- During busy season, will have less time to go to lunch with clients
- Focus during the busy season is to do as many tax returns as possible
 - Why some days will turn into 11 hour days
- Clients will be more pushy to know how much money to put aside and know how much money to owe or how much they will receive

What GPW does for the Employees

- Has lunch catered to them everyday during busy season
- Flexible work schedules
- Compensation to the employees that go above and beyond in their work
- GPW closes the office for a week after April 15th to allow the employees to rest and recharge
