Internal Auditors Assess Risks...

- To keep bad things from happening
- To help assure good things can happen
- To help management understand:
  - Where the risks are
  - Whether the risks are under control
  - Whether the risks are worth taking

Top risks in 2021

- Internal audit must build a robust program
- How do you build a versatile program and align capabilities and skills

Internal Auditors Assess Risks

- A "Working" inventory of business risks, for use by management and internal audit on a periodic basis

- Companies tend to have a Risk Register/ Risk Inventory
- Start the Register form top to bottom to see where the highest risk is to focus efforts on that area

Internal Audit Value:

- Internal Auditors very frequently perform data analytics and provide insight on areas that may have been overlooked
