### Questions:

1. What would you say to a student who is undecided on what service line they should go into? **Speak to peers who are years ahead and have completed internships in specific service lines to learn more about what they liked and didn't like. Speak to professors about opportunities in the field as well.**
2. If you are working in audit, are you working with multiple industries or just mainly one per year? **It is rare to leave specific sectors, but there is a variety of industries to work**

**in. If you don't like the current industry you work in, speak to your manager about a transition.**

3. As an information systems major, what opportunities are there for me? **Apply for specific roles that don't look for CPA requirements. There are a lot of roles that don't apply to only accounting majors at PwC.**
4. Are there any positions open this summer in San Diego? **Very unlikely with core practices. Audit and tax teams are looking for people in the Bay Area.**
5. How do you know if the CPA route is right for you? **It is a personal decision, there are some roles that do not require the CPA requirements.**
